Chennai doctors report surge in fungal infections

Chennai, Nov 22: The hot and humid weather of Chennai is making people more susceptible to skin fungal infection. Dermatologists across the globe have asked people to keep a check on their body's hygiene and wear washed and loose-fitted clothes always. Severe itching, redness and discomfort in groin or covered parts of body are some of the common symptoms of fungal infections.

Dr N Anand., M.D., D.N.B., Senior consultant Dermatologist & Venerologist, at Skin research centre Besant Nagar Chennai said Dermatophytic and yeast are common types of superficial fungal infections seen in humans. Dermatophytic

infection is identifiable as the common ringworm or tinea infection and yeast infections are seen predominantly in diabetic and immunosuppressed patients.

"Fungal infections cannot be treated at home. They need proper treatment with adequate

antifungal medication for a suitable length of time as there has been a marked increase in resistant fungal infections in India. Unhygienic quality of life is an aggravating aspect that encourages fungal infection and often leads to loss of sleep and social detachment due to severe

Madras university to offer Data Science distance programme

Chennai, Nov 22: Madras university to offer data science distance programme

CHENNAI: Buoyed by more admissions in distance mode courses, Institute of Distance Education (IDE) in Madras University is planning to start new courses in emerging areas such as BSc data science and MBA data analytics in distance mode from next year.

The university also plans to offer a BE degree programme in distance mode as there is high demand for teacher education degrees.

In the two admission sessions in 2022, IDE has attracted 37,208 students compared to 28,200 students in 2021. It is an increase of 32% compared to the previous year.

"We have the highest enrollment in the past five years in distance mode programmes. MBA courses accounted for more than 50% of total admissions," said S Aravindhan, director of IDE.

Besides MBA courses,

MCA, BCom, BBA, BA English also attracted more than 1,000 admissions this year.

New PG courses including Christian Studies, Journalism and Communication, Sociology and UG courses in French and Geography have attracted students.

As many as 576 diploma holders joined in BCA, BCom degree programmes through lateral entry in second year.

Based on the online survey, IDE has decided

to continue with the online mode classes instead of direct contact classes. "For lab-oriented courses, there will be physical classes. For other courses, contact classes will be online for now," Aravindhan said.

The university also plans to start its online degree programmes - nine PG degree programmes and three UG programmes from January 2023.

PG online courses include English, economics, anthropology, public administration,

cyber forensics, counselling psychology, MFA, MBA and MCom. It plans to offer BCom, BBA and BA in French in online mode.

"The learning management system (LMS) to offer online courses is ready and video lectures are being recorded. We expect more admissions to online degree programmes as they do not have any jurisdictional restrictions," Madras University vice-chancellor S Gowri said.
