The counselling process had ended on August 14. The deadline for direct admissions has now been extended to provide another opportunity for students who are yet to secure admission. Tamil Nadu has 132 government ITIs and 277 private ITIs. According to the department, about 95% of trainees who completed courses at ITIs in recent years secured jobs in leading industrial establishments. With demand for skilled workers increasing, ITI-trained candidates have employment opportunities in industries and multinational companies, particularly in Tamil Nadu. Depending on their skills, candidates could earn starting monthly salaries ranging from Rs 20,000 to Rs 30,000, the department said.
