

Mamata flays BJP for attack on Abhishek

Kolkata, May 31: Former West Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee and leaders of Opposition parties at the national level on Saturday condemned the alleged attack on Trinamool Congress National General Secretary Abhishek Banerjee and accused the BJP of fostering a politics of violence.

Abhishek Banerjee was allegedly attacked during his visit to Sonarpur in South 24 Parganas district. Banerjee had travelled to Sonarpur to meet the family of Sanju Karmakar, a Trinamool worker who was killed in post-poll violence.

According to the Trinamool Congress, the party leader faced protests on the way and was allegedly assaulted by a group of people.

Reacting to the incident, former Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee launched a strong attack on the state's BJP government, alleging that the ruling dispensation had become the aggressor. In a post

on X, she wrote: “The ruler has turned into the killer. The BJP should be ashamed.” The incident also drew reactions from leaders of INDIA bloc constituents. Samajwadi Party president Akhilesh Yadav and Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge condemned the alleged attack and questioned the role of the police.

In a post on X, Yadav alleged that the attack demonstrated the BJP government’s reliance on “hateful, negative and violent politics”. He further questioned the absence of police personnel at such a sensitive event, claiming that it pointed towards a larger conspiracy.

Kharge also denounced the incident, describing it as a “grievous attack” on the Trinamool leader. He alleged that the failure to provide adequate security to an Opposition leader reflected a politics of vendetta and intimidation.

Kharge urged both the Central and state

governments to ensure the safety of all Opposition leaders and take steps to prevent such incidents. He stressed that political differences should never translate into violence.

The BJP, however, rejected allegations linking the party to the Sonarpur incident. State BJP president Samik Bhattacharya said his party had no connection with what transpired during Banerjee’s visit.

“This incident is not linked to the BJP. Had the BJP wanted to retaliate for the alleged atrocities committed by the Trinamool Congress in South 24-Parganas over the past five years, Trinamool leaders would not have been able to step out of their homes. BJP workers have shown restraint,” Bhattacharya said.

While appealing for peace and restraint, he also questioned the absence of police deployment but maintained that the responsibility for law and order rested with

the state government. Referring to past incidents, Bhattacharya alleged that attempts had earlier been made to attack then Leader of the Opposition and now Chef Minister Suwendu Adhikari during his visits to North Bengal.

Meanwhile, the Trinamool Congress strongly condemned the alleged attack and praised Abhishek Banerjee for continuing with his visit despite the hostile situation. In a statement posted on the party’s social media account, the TMC said Banerjee had refused to abandon the bereaved family despite facing what it described as a “brutal attack” by “BJP-backed miscreants”.

The party further accused the BJP of practising politics based on fear, violence and revenge, contrasting it with what it termed Trinamool’s politics of compassion and solidarity with victims’ families.

Trump’s daughter Tiffany, husband visit Taj Mahal

Agra, May 31: Following the recent visit of US Secretary of State Marco Rubio, US President Donald Trump’s daughter Tiffany, along with her husband Michael Boulos, visited iconic Taj Mahal here today.

The couple spent about an hour exploring the Taj Mahal. Tiffany seemed delighted by the historical monument’s beauty and asked guide Ramesh Dhawan several questions. Ramesh explained the Taj Mahal’s history in detail.

The couple posed for photos not just holding hands but also in various poses. They also posed

for a group photo with their staff. Tiffany was seen in an orange long dress and Michael in a T-shirt and trousers. Both wore sunglasses.

Earlier, Tiffany’s chartered plane landed at Kheria Airport at 11:30 a.m. Instead of going to the hotel, her convoy headed straight to the Taj Mahal. Sitting in a golf cart, Tiffany and Michael entered the Taj Mahal complex, folding their hands and thanking the people. They were accompanied by US Ambassador to India Sergio Gor.

After leaving the Taj Mahal, Tiffany and Michael headed to the Amar Vilas Palace Hotel. The Taj

Mahal is clearly visible from the room Tiffany is staying in. After lunch, they departed by chartered plane for Jaisalmer, Rajasthan.

President Donald Trump visited the Taj Mahal with his wife Melania, daughter Ivanka and son-in-law Jared Kushner in 2000 during his first term.

Nearly six years later, another member of the Trump family has arrived in the Taj city. On May 25, US Secretary of State Marco Rubio visited the Taj Mahal with his wife, Janet.

Shivakumar to take oath on Jun 3 as CM

Bengaluru, May 31: Karnataka Governor Thaaawarch- and Gehlot on Saturday invited Karnataka Pradesh Congress Committee President DK Shivakumar to form the government in the state and take oath as the next Chief Minister.

In a formal communication issued from Lok Bhavan, the Governor said he had received Shivakumar’s letter dated May 30 staking claim to form the government after being elected leader of the Congress Legislature Party.

“I invite you to take oath as the

Chief Minister of Karnataka along with team members,” Gehlot said in the letter.The Governor informed that the swearing-in ceremony would be held at 4.05 p.m. on June 3 at the Lok Bhavan premises in Bengaluru.The invitation formally sets in motion the process for the formation of a new Congress government in Karnataka under Shivakumar’s leadership following the party’s decision to appoint him as the CLP leader.

The oath-taking ceremony is expected to be attended by senior Congress leaders, party legislators

and dignitaries from across the country.

Earlier in the day, the Congress Legislature Party (CLP) unanimously endorsed the proposal moved by outgoing Chief Minister Siddaramaiah to elect DK Shivakumar as its leader, clearing the way for him to assume office as Karnataka’s next Chief Minister.

Siddaramaiah subsequently stepped down from the post, bringing to an end months of intense speculation and a protracted power tussle between the two influential Congress stalwarts.

Close to Iran peace deal, claims Trump

Washington D.C., May 31: US President Donald Trump said that the United States was now “slowly but surely” getting close to a very good deal with Iran, but if it didn’t happen, the US would return to military action.

“If you’re going to be in a hurry, you are not going to make a good deal. And slowly but surely, we’re getting, I think, what we want. And if we do not get what we want, we are going to end it a different

way,” the US leader said in an interview with his daughter-in-law, Lara Trump, on Fox News.

Meanwhile, Iran’s Islamic Revolutionary Guard Corps (IRGC) claimed it detected and shot down a US MQ-1 Predator multi-role drone over the country’s territorial waters early Sunday morning, the Tasnim news agency reported.

Early this morning, a US Army MQ1 drone entered Iranian territorial waters, but was immediately

detected and hit by missiles from the IRGC air defense system, the agency said, citing the IRGC’s statement.

It noted that the US drone had entered Iranian territorial waters “with the intention of committing hostile acts.” On February 28, the United States and Israel began striking targets in Iran, killing more than 3,000 people.

Gold-winning para-athlete murdered in UP

Ghaziabad, May 31: International Indian para-athlete Chirag Tyagi was shot dead in Ghaziabad on Saturday. Chirag was murdered by fellow athlete Yash Khatik. At the time of the incident, Chirag was returning home after winning gold at the Indian Open Para Athletics International Championships in Bengaluru. This victory had qualified him for the Asian Para Games.

Chirag’s body was found in Sai Upvan in the Hindon area. He had a bullet wound on his back. Chirag Tyagi was a resident of Ghaziabad. He competed in the 100 and 400-metre races. Chirag brought glory to the country with his outstanding performances on national and international platforms.

ACP Upasana Pandey said here on Sunday that based on CCTV footage, the police have detained Yash Khatik. He confessed to the murder during interrogation.

Police said the investigation revealed that Chirag and his friend had travelled from Delhi to Hindon by a cab. They

then went to Sai Upvan, where Chirag was murdered. Based on the CCTV footage, police detained Yash Khatik, a resident of Muradnagar.

DCP Dhawal Jaiswal said, “During interrogation, Yash Khatik revealed

that he, too, is a para-athlete. He previously practiced with Chirag Tyagi. They even participated in competitions together. Once, during document verification, Chirag Tyagi filed a complaint against Yash. This resulted in

Yash’s qualification being cancelled. Yash Khatik was upset about this.” In revenge, Yash shot Chirag Tyagi with a pistol and killed him. Based on a complaint from his family, the police have registered a murder case.

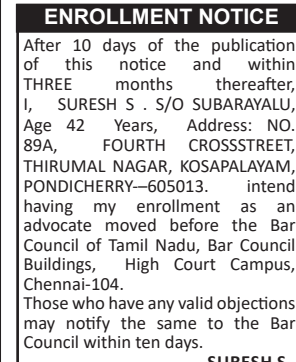
